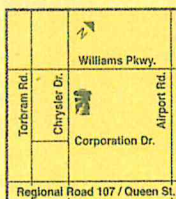

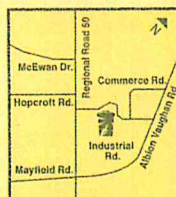
Battleford Community Recycling Centre

Evening Hours: Thurs. until 8 p.m.*



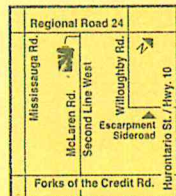
Brampton Community Recycling Centre

SHARPS

CORRECT DISPOSAL

Dispose of sharps – needles, syringes, & lancets – at one of Peel's Community Recycling Centres (CRCs).

This service is for residents **only**, not businesses.

DO

- Get your **FREE** biohazard container at a CRC.
- Store your sharps in your biohazard container.
- Bring your biohazard container to a CRC for **FREE** disposal.
- Get a **FREE** replacement biohazard container at a CRC.

OR

- Ask if your pharmacy offers the same service through the Ontario Sharps Collection Program. Check healthsteward.ca/returns/Ontario



DO NOT

- Do not put your sharps in the garbage, recycling or organics.
- Do not bring your sharps to a CRC in anything but a biohazard container. CRCs only accept sharps in biohazard containers.

HOME HEALTH-CARE WASTE

CORRECT DISPOSAL

Dispose of it in the garbage.

Home health-care waste includes:

- catheters
- colostomy bags
- dialysis waste
- IV bags and tubing

DO

- Double-bag your home health-care waste.
- Place it in the garbage.
- Ask how to be added to the Region's medical waste exemption list if your home health-care waste exceeds your garbage capacity. Contact:
