## SENIORS & ADULTS with DISABILITIES

*Supporting clients' personal preferences and promoting independence for clients to remain safely in their homes for as long as possible*



**Home Help** (fee geared to income—must require at least 2 services below to qualify)

- ✓ Housekeeping and Laundry
- ✓ Grocery Shopping
- ✓ Meal Preparation
- ✓ Appointment accompaniment (via taxi/public transit at client cost)

**Bathing** (free)

Personal support workers provide weekly in-home bathing services.

**Caregiver Relief** (free & fee based)

PSWs provide in-home relief for eligible caregivers supporting loved ones.

**Meals on Wheels** (fee based)

Delicious, nutritious, affordable meals for pick up or delivery

- ✓ Meals on Wheels hot lunches
- ✓ Frozen Meals—choice of 50+ entrees, soups & desserts

**Wheels to Meals** (fee based)

Social luncheons at local restaurants with transportation by volunteers



**Home Maintenance** (fee based)

- ✓ Lawn & Garden Care
- ✓ Grab Bar or Shelf Installation
- ✓ Windows & Seasonal Cleaning
- ✓ Eaves Troughs
- ✓ Painting & Repairs

**Community Navigation** (free)

Coordinators assist those in transition or in crisis situations by helping with:

- ✓ Health care system navigation
- ✓ Housing applications
- ✓ Hoarding issues
- ✓ Accessing financial support
- ✓ Elder abuse
- ✓ Mental health referrals

**Friendly Visiting** (free)

Volunteers visit isolated clients for safety checks, support, and socializing.

**Supportive Housing** (Acton)

PSWs provide supports for daily living for eligible residents at Lakeview Villa.

for children 4-10 years of age at Park and Joseph Gibbons Public Schools in Georgetown

**Parenting Support** and information on child development, parenting, and early years services.

**Recreation & Sport Funding**

Canadian Tire Jumpstart Program subsidizes extracurricular activities.

**Backpacks & School Supplies**

Distributed with the help of high school students earning volunteer hours.

**Holiday Giving** enables individuals/businesses/groups to sponsor families with new clothing and toiletries.

## COMMUNITY SUPPORT FOR ALL AGES

**Support & Advocacy** Help filling out forms, making phone calls, and navigating government services

**Food & Other Essentials** (clothes, toiletries, household items) are available to those in need

**Income Tax Program** CRA trained volunteers complete income tax returns for eligible residents

**Help with Utilities** Access to subsidies and emergency funding for gas or electricity bills.

**Homelessness Intervention** Support for housing insecurity and related issues.
