## **Eligible Candidates**



Must have a doctors referral, hold a valid Ontario Health Card (OHIP) and meet program criteria.

#### Criteria:

- ☐ Aged 18 years of age and older ☐ Frail Elderly
- Medically stable
- · Recent neurological diagnosis/condition:
  - Stroke Acquired Brain Injury Parkinsons
  - Brain Tumor Guillain-Barre Syndrome
  - Multiple Sclerosis Other Neurodegenerative Diseases
- Functional deficit requiring assessment & intervention:
  - · Difficulty walking or loss of balance
  - Loss of strength, range of motion, and/or motor control of upper/lower extremities
  - · Changes to speech or communication
  - · Increased difficulty swallowing or managing meals
  - Making modifications to foods/avoiding types of foods
  - · Changes to cognitive skills and/or perceptual abilities
- · Must be motivated to attain reasonable goals
- Have the potential to regain their functional loss so that they are no longer at high risk ('restorative potential')
- Must be able to tolerate participation in active rehabilitation
   2-3 times per week for a period of 6-8 weeks.
- · Live in the Mississauga-Halton LHIN Region
