

REFERRALS TO ARMAGH

You have been provided this information package, out-lining the referral process and requirements for residing at Armagh. You may be considering a referral to Armagh. (A referral does not guarantee you a space at Armagh) Please ensure that you read and understand the information below while considering this option. Referral Process:

Armagh accepts referrals from the local crisis shelters and the Peel Children's Aid Domestic Violence Team. Based on your individual situation, your worker may suggest that you consider a referral to Armagh. You and your worker will then complete the referral form and send it to Armagh. Armagh will review all referrals submitted based on availability.

The Following considerations are reviewed for all Armagh Referrals:

The woman's family size

The woman's specific needs besides housing, meets Armagh criteria and would benefit from the support of Armagh and would positively contribute to the environment of Armagh

Interviews:

When an interview is offered Armagh staff will contact the referring worker. Only those offered an interview would be contacted. An interview date and time will be arranged mutually with the woman, worker and an Armagh staff member. The interview will take approximately 1 hour. Armagh is not able to provide childcare during this interview so please ensure childcare arrangements prior to your arrival.

Conditional offer of housing:

Following the interview the referring worker will be notified if an offer is to be made or not.

When Armagh is making a conditional offer to a woman, we ask that you consider the following:

- ❖ You agree to abide by the rules/guidelines, please be aware that these may not be all of the guidelines or rules to be followed while residing at Armagh. A full list will be provided during intake
- ❖ You agree to and actively participate in any programs. If a woman is working or at school and cannot attend it is her responsibility to find out what was discussed at the session.
- ❖ You must pay your rent on time Rent is based on Rent Geared to Income if you work staff will work out the amount of your rent based on your pay stubs showing your 'gross' earnings. If you are on Ontario Works then your rent will be the amount OW gives you marked for 'shelter'
- ❖ You must maintain a clean and safe unit- Staff of Armagh complete regular unit checks, we are looking for maintenance issues, health and safety issues and monitoring the cleanliness of the units.
- ❖ Families live in self-contained furnished apartments/units at Armagh. You would maintain this unit, cook your own meals, do your grocery shopping etc. Armagh is an independent living environment with supports. Armagh staff will assist you in wherever possible during your stay.

A LITTLE BIT ABOUT ARMAGH

BUSINESS:

There are two (2) staff, a Transitional Housing Support worker and Child and Youth Worker. Both provide direct service/support to the women and children living at Armagh. The hours of business are Monday – Friday 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. From time to time we may also have students completing their field placement.

Moving In – Move ins are completed on Mondays – Thursdays at 11:00 a.m. or 1:00 p.m. These times are specific due to other work commitments of staff and the length of time it takes to complete an intake. It is very important when a successful candidate has been given a move in time that she arrive at Armagh on time as scheduled otherwise the moving day may have to be changed but she will have to pay the rent from the original date given for move-in, since the unit has been reserved for that particular woman.

Moving Out – Move outs are completed Monday – Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. again these times reflect the necessary amount of time required to complete a smooth move out.

RESPECT:

It is an expectation of Armagh that residents will make every effort to get along with the other residents. We do however recognize that at times you may not like every woman or child that is living at Armagh. We do expect that everyone will treat and greet each other with respect and dignity.

We need all residents to respect the property of Armagh both inside and outside the house. It is also the residents' responsibility to maintain a clean and safe apartment unit. Armagh staff complete unit checks on a regular basis, if you are out, we will enter to do our inspections for maintenance issues, and to ensure the apartments are being maintained in a way that provides a healthy and safe environment. It is also the mother's responsibility to ensure her children clean up the play areas when they are finished playing.

SAFETY AND SECURITY:

- ❖ There are no visitors allowed on Armagh property without pre-approval by Armagh staff.
- ❖ Under no circumstances is the address and location of Armagh to be given.



- * Residents are not to discuss other residents to people not living or working at Armagh.
- Support groups/programs are mandatory for all residents to attend.

POSSIBLE EVICTION:

It is rare that Armagh staff find that they must evict a resident from its property; however there are situations that arise that leave us no other choice. We believe it is only fair to inform you of the reasons that you could be evicted from your unit. This way you can make choices that enhance your stay at Armagh rather than hinder your stay. Listed below are the rules that must be followed;

- ❖ No alcohol on the property
- ❖ No candles/incense burning on the property
- ❖ No smoking in your unit
- ❖ No deep frying in the building
- ❖ No illegal drugs of any kind on the property
- ❖ Non payment of rent
- * Having continuous difficulty with other residents in regards to cooperative living.

If while you are living at Armagh and we should determine that you have not been seen or have had no contact with staff for 3-4 days and have not informed staff that you will be away for an extended period of time;

Staff Will:

- Enter your unit to check and see if you are there
- Attempt to contact you
- Attempt to call your emergency contact person to make contact with you If we are unable to make contact through the above steps we will then call the police and report you missing.
